



The service at Al Medinah Mosque is conducted in two parts:

**PART 1- The Initial Meeting.**

In this meeting, we will determine and discuss the following:

- Full names of both parties
- Faith of both parties
- Citizenship status of both parties
- Address of both parties
- Date of birth for both parties
- Previous marriages
- Wali (representative) of the Bride
- Mahr
- Names and addresses of witnesses

The following documents will be required:

- 1 Valid photo ID showing your name and date of birth (if British citizen)
- Valid passport with visa for Foreigners (Non-British citizens)- If a visa is not required for your stay in the country, please notify us.
- Valid ID to prove residential address (utility bill, bank statements etc. No more than 3 months old)
- Proof of Divorce (if applicable)
- Proof of Walis consent (if required)

These documents will be copied and kept as part of our records.

The Imam will now arrange a date for the Nikah. This will be based on the availability of the Imam and a date that suits you. Please do not expect an immediate appointment.

**PART 2- The Nikaah ceremony**

The Nikah ceremony consists of the Khutbah (sermon) and the exchanging of vows. The following is required for the Nikah ceremony:

- Presence of the Bridegroom
- Presence of the Bride (optional)
- Presence of the Wali (representative)
- Two Muslim male witnesses

Upon the completion of the ceremony you will be presented with a “Nikah” certificate.

Please bear in mind the following:

- Meetings are conducted at the Imams convenience.
- The Nikah service is conducted in the Masjid. They will not be conducted elsewhere unless agreed with the Imam. (You may be expected to cover travel expenses)
- There will be a £100 charge for this service. Please ensure this is paid in the first meeting.
- In the case of revert sisters who have no Wali (representative), please inform us beforehand so we can make suitable arrangements.
- Please ensure you respect the honour of the Masjid when you attend for the Nikah ceremony. Family members or friends who may not be aware of how to behave around the Masjid should be informed of the basic requirements.

Once you have read the above guidelines and understood them, you may now contact the Mosque to organise your first meeting. You can do this by contacting the following:
